Bright Futures is working with longterm partner, Bangalore City Mission to build a school and education facility for children in Rajankunte village, on the outskirts of Bangalore, India.

The school will provide free and low-fee education for children from families that cannot afford to send their children to school.

The proposed school development will offer education to 3,000 children, regardless of religion, race or caste in Rajankunte village and surrounding regions.

Children from slums, rock quarries, local villages, and refugee camps will all be welcome to attend school and change their future.

CONSTRUCTION IS PLANNED IN 4 STAGES:

Stage 1 Purchase of land (2023)

Stage 2

Planning, consultation, final drawings and building approvals (2024)

Stage 3

Construction of School Classroom Block and Admin Block (Jan 2025 - Jan 2027)

Stage 4

Future plans - Auditorium, proposed University (Jan 2027 onwards)

With a rapidly growing population, along with shortages of teachers, books, basic facilities, and insufficient public funds, not every child in India is able to go to school.

In Rajankunte, a large farming village, many families are experiencing extreme poverty. Parents are in daily survival mode as they search for work to buy food to feed their family, leaving no extra money to pay for school.

Without access to schooling, many children find themselves trapped in poverty with little hope of escape.

Bangalore City Mission's vision is to use education and community development initiatives to help children and families experience transformational change today and for future generations.
